Summary

Albania last reported information on hate crime to ODIHR for the 2021 Hate Crime Report. In co-operation with the OSCE Presence in Albania, Albania has trained law enforcement officers on hate crimes. Albania has made efforts to improve systems for hate crime data recording and allow the bias motivation to be identified in recorded cases through ODIHR's Expert workshop on improving hate crime recording and data collection, organized in 2017.

ODIHR's Key Observation

ODIHR recognizes Albania's efforts to build the capacities of law enforcement agencies in responding to hate crimes. However, based on available information, ODIHR observes that, currently, Albania does not collect data and statistics on hate crimes. In addition, ODIHR observes that Albania would benefit from raising awareness among and building the capacity of criminal justice officials to address hate crime.
